The Missing Map

- ① At 7:45, Maya stood by the school office microphone. “Good morning, students and staff. The library’s large wall map is missing. If you borrowed it for a project, please return it to Ms. Ortiz by Friday.” She checked the note in her hand and added, “The map is needed for next week’s geography fair.” In the hallway, Maya saw her friend Theo. “Hey, the big map vanished,” she said. “Did you grab it for your volcano project?”
- ② That afternoon, Maya wrote a message for the student council website: “The library is requesting the return of a laminated world map, approximately four feet wide. Please deliver the map to the library desk before 3:00 p.m. Friday.” She chose a photo of the map and placed it beside the message. Within an hour, three students stopped by the desk. One said he had seen the map near the art room, where paint supplies were being moved for a mural.
- ③ On Friday, Maya spoke at the geography fair. “Thank you to everyone who looked for the map,” she began. “It was found behind the art-room supply cart, and no one was in trouble.” Then she held up the map while visitors gathered around. Theo whispered, “Mystery solved.” Maya smiled but continued, “The library will keep the map in a labeled case after the fair.” The crowd clapped when Ms. Ortiz thanked the students who had returned it.
