HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Show students that an uppercase letter and a lowercase letter can be partners. In this sheet, students find letter partners, then practice printing the letter shapes by tracing.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MATCH PARTNERS

SAY “Each big letter on the left has a lowercase partner on the right. Can you draw a line from each letter on the left to its partner?”

- **A** matches **a**
- **D** matches **d**
- **M** matches **m**
- **T** matches **t**

PART 2 • TRACE LETTERS

SAY “Look at the gray letter in each box. Can you trace each letter carefully?”

- Box 1: **G**
- Box 2: **g**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept lines connecting A to a, D to d, M to m, and T to t. Accept recognizable traced G and g, including developmentally appropriate letter formation.
