She wrote a note with the words, "Birds need safe places to rest." The next morning, she saw two wrens near the birdhouse. They hopped on the grass and looked up at the new roof.
- ③ Maya and her uncle came outside after breakfast. They carried the birdhouse to a tall post. Her uncle fastened it securely near the top. Maya stood back and watched. Soon, a wren came close. It went into the birdhouse and came out again. Maya whispered, "We made a good place." The bird then sang from a nearby branch.
