Bean Plant Check

- ① On Monday, Ms. Chen's class checked three bean plants in the school garden. Plant A stood taller than Plant B, but Plant C was the tallest plant. Each plant had green leaves and a thin stem. The class used a ruler to measure from the soil to the top leaf. They wrote the height of every plant in a notebook.
- ② By Friday, Plant B had grown faster than Plant A. The children checked the plants at the same time each day, so their measurements were fair. Plant C grew the fastest during the week because it gained four centimeters. Its spot near the window received bright sunlight for many hours. The class knew that light and water help bean plants grow.
- ③ During the next check, Ana wrote the measurements most carefully, and Leo placed the ruler more neatly beside each stem. Ms. Chen said that clear notes help the class see changes. At the end of the month, the class will choose the healthiest plant to move into a larger pot. They will compare its new growth with the other plants.
