Postcards for a Seed Swap

- ① On Saturday, Maya helped her aunt write postcards for a pretend seed swap. Each card gave a made-up meeting place: Green Corner Garden, 18 Willow Lane, Brookdale, Oregon 97005. Maya wrote the street number and street name first. Then she added the town, state, and ZIP Code. She checked that each part of the address was easy for the mail carrier to read.
- ② One postcard went to Eli Chen, 402 Maple Street, Brookdale, Oregon 97005. Eli planned to bring bean seeds from the school garden. Another postcard went to the library at 7 Harbor Road, Brookdale, Oregon 97005. The librarian planned a small display of books about plants. Maya placed the cards in the mailbox before dinner that evening.
- ③ Before the event, Maya's aunt posted directions near the garden gate. She listed the garden address as Green Corner Garden, 18 Willow Lane, Brookdale, Oregon 97005. She also wrote a return location for extra postcards: 55 Pine Court, Brookdale, Oregon 97005. At the seed swap, neighbors found the garden, traded seeds, and took postcards home with them.
