Her teacher explained that this anamal uses tiny tube feet to move and to hold food. Mia wanted her notes to be clear, so she planned to check each uncertain word in a beginning dictionary.
- ② Next, Mia watched a small crab slip under a piece of seaweed. A crab has a hard shell that protects its soft body. Mia wrote that the crab moved sideways to hide from a bird. She was not sure about that spelling. She opened her dictionary, looked at the first letter, and used the guide words at the top of the pages.
- ③ Before leaving, Mia noticed a snail scraping algae from a stone. Sea snails use a rough, tongue-like part to eat algae. Mia spelled the word beutiful when she described the pool. In the dictionary, she found the word by checking nearby words. Her final notes also said that she would return to the beach tomorrow.
