A Rainy Garden Workday

- ② After the team finished planting, a light rain began. Maya and Leo moved the tools under a wooden table, so they would stay dry. Oh no! One paper plant label blew across the path. Leo chased it between two benches, and Maya held the gate open. Because the rain ended quickly, the group returned to the beds with their watering can.
- ③ By noon, the garden looked different from the empty space they had seen that morning. The carrots were hidden below the soil, yet their labels stood beside each row. Hooray! Maya knew the seeds needed water, sunlight, and time. She placed the can beside the shed after the workday, then walked home with Leo. They hoped to taste crisp carrots at lunch in the fall.

2	What feeling does "Wow!" show in the first paragraph, and what causes that feeling?	It shows surprise or delight because the soil feels cool and crumbly.
3	In the second paragraph, how does under tell where Maya and Leo moved the tools?	It tells that they moved the tools below a wooden table.
4	In "Because the rain ended quickly, the group returned to the beds," what relationship does Because show?	It shows the reason the group returned to the beds: the rain ended quickly.
