Inside a Honeybee Hive

- ① On a warm morning, worker honeybees leave the hive to search for nectar and pollen. A bee may visit hundreds of flowers during one trip. Nectar is carried back in a special stomach, while pollen is packed onto hairy baskets on the bee's legs. At the hive, the gathered nectar is passed to other workers. These workers fan their wings, and water is removed from the nectar. The thickened food becomes honey, which is stored in wax cells.
- ② Inside the hive, different jobs are performed by workers of different ages. Young workers clean cells and feed larvae, which are the developing bees. Later, some workers guard the entrance. Others receive nectar from returning foragers and place it in cells. The queen lays eggs, but she does not direct every task. Her chemical signals help organize the colony. Male bees, called drones, are raised mainly to mate with a queen from another colony. In cold weather, the hive is kept warm by workers that cluster together.
- ③ Beekeepers sometimes inspect hives to check the health of a colony. During an inspection, frames are lifted carefully so the wax comb is not damaged. A beekeeper may look for eggs, larvae, stored honey, and signs of disease. If a colony becomes crowded, a new queen cell can be built by the workers. Then part of the colony may leave with a queen to form a new home, a process called swarming. Healthy hives pollinate many flowering plants, and crops are helped when bees carry pollen between blossoms.
