HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each part aloud and point to the columns or boxes as you speak. This sheet practices recognizing and printing uppercase and lowercase letters, an important Kindergarten grammar and usage skill.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MATCH LETTERS

SAY “Look at the big letters on the left and the small letters on the right. Can you draw a line from each big letter to its same small letter?”

- **A** matches **a**
- **M** matches **m**
- **S** matches **s**

PART 2 • TRACE LETTERS

SAY “Look at each gray letter. Can you trace the letter in each box?”

- Box 1: **C**
- Box 2: **t**
- Box 3: **P**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Match A to a, M to m, and S to s. Accept recognizable traced letter forms, including letters that are not yet perfectly shaped.
