HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read all headings, choices, and prompts aloud. Students listen for which question word fits the idea, then circle or connect the printed word.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each question. I will read the words in the row. Which question word fits? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which question word asks about time? The choices are when, why, and how. Which one will you circle?	when
b	Which question word asks for a reason? The choices are who, why, and where. Which one will you circle?	why
c	Which question word asks about the way something happens? The choices are how, when, and what. Which one will you circle?	how

PART 2 • DRAW LINES

SAY “I will read the words on the left and right. Which question word asks about a person, a thing, or a place? Draw a line from each question word to what it asks about.”

- **who** matches **person**
- **what** matches **thing**
- **where** matches **place**

Circle when, why, and how in order. Match who to person, what to thing, and where to place.
