A Barn Owl at Night

- ① At dusk, a barn owl may leave its shelter and fly low over a field. Its pale face and brown wings can be hard to spot. The owl listens for small animals moving below the grass.
- ② Owls do not build nests in every tree. Some use old barns, hollow trunks, or quiet boxes. A mother owl may lay several eggs, and the young owls grow soft feathers before they learn to fly.
- ③ On a snowy night, an owl can hunt by sound. It may fly low, then swoop down without much noise. After a meal, the owl may rest in an old barn until the sky grows light.
