- ② Maya read a sign once, then stopped. The last word began with Clammi-. Her uncle pointed to people with small buckets, digging in wet sand. Maya read the sign again and understood why they were there.
- ③ Near a tall rock, a gull swooped down and snatched a crab from the sand. Another crab vanished under a flat shell. Maya whispered, "It found shelter." She reread the line and nodded as the gull flew away.

#	QUESTION	ANSWER
1	Reread the first paragraph. What does peered most likely mean? Which words help you decide?	Peered means looked closely. "Bent low" and "at a small crab" are clues.
2	Reread the second paragraph. What word most likely completes Clammi-? What clues help you check the word?	Clamming. The letters "Clammi-" and people digging in wet sand with buckets are clues.
3	Reread the last paragraph. What does shelter most likely mean? What happened that helped you decide?	Shelter means a safe hiding place. A gull took a crab, and the other crab went under a shell.
