Maya's Garden Crew

- ① On Saturday, Maya joined a local garden crew. The workers pulled weeds and carried water to dry beds. Maya was hopeful when she saw tiny green shoots near the fence. A helpful neighbor showed her how to replant a loose tomato seedling. Soon, each plant stood straight, and the garden looked more colorful than before.
- ② On Monday, the crew found that some leaves were colorless after a cold night. Maya did not feel helpless. She and another helper covered the beds with cloth. The cloth gave the plants a warmer space. By noon, the leaves looked less pale, and Maya's careful work had saved the smallest plants from the cold.
- ③ At the end of the month, Maya made a sign for the garden gate. She wrote, "Please be kind to the new plants." Her sign asked visitors not to step on beds or pick flowers without asking. A small watering station let families refill cans. The garden's kindness brought neighbors together, even after the work was finished.

PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)

I repainted the old bench, and our help(ful) teacher brought brushes. The dark(ness) faded when we turned on the lights. Darkness means the state of being dark.

Accept underlined words such as workers, hopeful, helpful, replant, colorful, colorless, helpless, helper, careful, refill, and kindness when the student correctly circles the meaningful prefix or derivational suffix. Do not require inflectional endings such as -ed, -ing, or -est.
