A Book's Second Life

- ① At the town library, damaged books do not always go to the trash. Ms. Inez leads a book repair station each Friday. She checks for loose pages, torn covers, and bent corners. Her careful work gives many books a second life. A repaired book can be readable again, so another child can borrow it for enjoyment.
- ② First, Ms. Inez makes a list of supplies. Clear tape is useful for a small tear, while a special glue helps with a loose page. She uses a ruler to keep the tape straight. Then she writes a short note inside the cover. The note tells readers that the book has had a repair, not a replacement.
- ③ Book repair is a helpful way to reduce waste. It also teaches responsibility. When readers return books on time and handle them gently, fewer books need fixing. The library's collection stays stronger, and the community saves money. Ms. Inez says every repaired book is a small reminder that materials can be valuable for a long time.
