HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row prompt aloud and give students time to circle one letter. In the matching part, students show that a capital letter and a lowercase letter can have the same name by drawing connecting lines.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • FIND IT

SAY “Look at the big letters in each row. I will read the letters and ask for one letter. Can you circle the letter I ask for?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Do you see M, W, and N? Which letter is M? Circle it.	M
b	Do you see P, R, and B? Which letter is R? Circle it.	R
c	Do you see C, O, and G? Which letter is G? Circle it.	G

PART 2 • LINK LETTERS

SAY “Look at the capital letters on the left and the lowercase letters on the right. Can you draw a line from each capital letter to the lowercase letter with the same name?”

- **D** matches **d**
- **H** matches **h**
- **T** matches **t**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept circles around M, R, and G only. Accept lines D to d, H to h, and T to t.
