**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read every printed choice aloud because students are working with sounds, not independent reading. In Part 1, students blend a first sound with an ending chunk. In Part 2, students say a whole word slowly and identify the ending chunk after its first sound.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • BUILD WORDS**

**SAY** “Listen as I say two word parts. Put the parts together in your head, then listen to the words in the row. Which word do you hear?”

| c   | Listen: /h/ ... /op/. I will read hip, hop, hot. Which word do you hear? Circle it. | <b>hop</b>      |

**PART 2 • MATCH ENDINGS**

**SAY** “Say each word in the left column slowly with me. Listen for the part after the first sound. I will read the ending chunks in the right column. Can you draw a line from each word to its ending chunk?”

- **dog** matches **og**
- **jam** matches **am**
- **sit** matches **it**

**WHAT TO ACCEPT**

Part 1: cap, sun, hop. Part 2: dog to og, jam to am, and sit to it. Accept a clear circle or line, even if it is not neatly drawn.
