Beavers at Work

- ① Beavers are busy builders that live near streams and ponds. Their wide, flat tails help them swim and balance on land. Strong front teeth let beavers cut small trees and branches. A beaver's thick fur helps keep its body warm in cold water.
- ② To make a pond, beavers place branches, mud, and stones across a moving stream. This dam slows the water. Water collects behind the dam, making a deeper pond. The pond gives beavers a safer place to swim and find food.
- ③ Beavers often build a home called a lodge in the pond. The lodge may have an underwater door, which can help keep some animals out. In autumn, beavers store branches near the lodge. They eat bark and twigs during winter.
