A Beaver's Busy Work

- ① Beavers are animals that live near ponds, lakes, and streams. They use their strong teeth to cut small trees and branches. A beaver carries the wood to water, where it can build a home or a dam.
- ② A dam is a wall of wood, mud, and stones. It slows moving water. Water collects behind the dam and may form a pond. The pond gives beavers a safer place to swim and reach their lodge.
- ③ Beaver dams can also help other living things. Fish, frogs, and water birds may use the pond for food or shelter. The wet ground around a pond can help plants grow. A beaver's work changes its habitat.
