How Beavers Make a Lodge

- ① Beavers build homes called lodges beside ponds or streams. A lodge has a dry room inside, above the water. The animals use their strong teeth to cut small trees and branches for building.
- ② First, a beaver piles branches and mud near the shore. Then it adds more sticks, making walls that hold together. An underwater entrance helps the beaver slip into its home while staying safer from many land animals.
- ③ Beavers keep fixing their lodges as weather changes. In cold places, a pond may freeze on top. The beaver can still swim below the ice to reach the lodge entrance and its stored food.
