More Trees for Riverside

- ① Riverside should plant more trees in its parks. On sunny days, leaves make shade. The shade helps children and families stay cooler when they play, walk, or sit outside. More trees would make park visits more comfortable.
- ② Trees can also help keep park soil in place. Their roots hold the ground together. When rain falls, less soil may wash away. This helps keep dirt out of nearby streams, where animals need clean water.
- ③ Finally, trees give birds places to build nests and find food. People can watch birds in the parks. Shade, strong soil, and homes for birds show why park trees matter in Riverside.
