HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the choices in each row aloud, then read the question. Students show the book part they identify by circling one printed choice in each row.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • FIND IT

SAY “I will read the three choices and then ask a question. Which book part should you circle?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: Title Page, Back Cover, Front Cover. Which part is on the outside of a book at the beginning?	Front Cover
b	Listen: Title Page, Front Cover, Back Cover. Which part is on the outside of a book at the end?	Back Cover
c	Listen: Back Cover, Title Page, Front Cover. Which part is an inside page where you can find the book's title?	Title Page

PART 2 • BOOK HUNT

SAY “Listen to each choice and question. Which book part should you circle this time?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: Front Cover, Title Page, Back Cover. When a book is closed, which outside part do you see on the beginning side?	Front Cover
b	Listen: Back Cover, Front Cover, Title Page. After you open a book, which inside page may show the book's name?	Title Page
c	Listen: Title Page, Back Cover, Front Cover. Which outside part is on the ending side of a closed book?	Back Cover

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are Front Cover, Back Cover, Title Page. Part 2 answers are Front Cover, Title Page, Back Cover.
