**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read each short text aloud twice, then read one question at a time. Students show an answer by circling one printed word or number. Listen for whether students use details from the text to answer who, what, where, and how many questions.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • HAT STORY**

**SAY** “Listen to this text two times: “Mia has a hat. She wears it to the park. A dog runs past Mia.” After each question, circle one answer.”

**SAY** “Listen to this text two times: “Ben has three coins. He puts the coins in a jar. Ben shakes the jar.” After each question, circle one answer.”
