- ① On Saturday morning, Maya and her grandpa visited the community garden behind the library. They carried a small paper bag of bean seeds. Maya wanted to help make a new garden bed for neighbors to enjoy.
- ② First, Grandpa showed Maya how to loosen the soil with a hand rake. Next, Maya dropped three seeds into each little hole. She covered the seeds gently, then gave them water from a green can.
- ③ Before they left, Maya placed a wooden sign by the bed. It said, “Beans Growing Here.” She hoped visitors would know what was planted and would not step on the tiny seeds underground.
