Sunflowers for the Fair

- ① Mina carried three sunflower seedlings to the school garden. She wanted to plant them before the family night fair. When she reached the garden, she saw that the ground was hard and dry. Her small shovel would not dig a hole.
- ② Mina frowned, but she did not leave. She filled a watering can at the faucet and poured water on the soil. Then she waited while her friend Jo brought a larger shovel from the shed.
- ③ After they planted the seedlings, a rabbit nibbled one plant. Mina felt worried. She placed a wire basket around each seedling and asked Jo to help her check the garden each morning. At the fair, all three plants stood tall.

3	What do Mina's actions tell you about her when problems happen?	She is determined and works to solve problems instead of giving up.
