The Quiet Bridge

- ① After a night of hard rain, Maya hurried toward the footbridge that led to school. A stream usually slipped under the bridge, but today brown water rushed over its wooden boards. On the far bank, Maya saw her neighbor Mr. Lee holding a bag of library books. He waved, then looked at the water with worried eyes.
- ② Maya wanted to cross, but she remembered her teacher's rule about floodwater: never step into water when you cannot see the ground. She called to Mr. Lee, "We should find another way." Mr. Lee pointed upstream, where a wide stone path curved through the park. It would take longer, and Maya might be late, but the path stayed dry.
- ③ They walked through the wet park together. Near the stone path, they found a small turtle upside down in a puddle. Maya gently turned it over with a leaf, and it crawled into tall grass. When they reached school, Maya was late, but her teacher listened. "You made careful choices," she said. Maya smiled and opened her damp notebook.

1	What problem does Maya see when she gets to the footbridge?	Brown floodwater is rushing over the wooden boards of the bridge.
2	Why does Maya decide not to cross the bridge?	She remembers that she should not step into water when she cannot see the ground.
3	What route do Maya and Mr. Lee take instead?	They take the wide stone path through the park.
4	What careful choices did Maya make in the story?	She chose the dry path instead of crossing floodwater, and she gently helped the upside-down turtle.

PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)

Maya finds that floodwater covers the bridge to school. She and Mr. Lee take a longer, dry path through the park, where Maya helps a turtle. Maya arrives late, but her teacher says she made careful choices.
