### The Silent Radio

- ① On Saturday, Nia carried her grandfather's old radio to the neighborhood repair fair. It had stopped making music, and she hoped to surprise him before his birthday. At the first table, a volunteer showed her a loose wire inside. Nia tried to connect it, but her fingers shook, and the wire slipped away again twice.
- ② Nia wanted to leave, but she remembered how her grandfather fixed things slowly at his kitchen table. She took a breath and asked the volunteer to show her again. This time, she rested her elbows on the table and used small pliers. The wire clicked into place, but the radio was still silent for now.
- ③ A second volunteer suggested checking the batteries. Nia found white powder on one battery and replaced it with a fresh one. When music finally filled the room, Nia grinned. She thanked both volunteers and wrote down what they had taught her. At home, her grandfather listened to the radio and said, "You kept working until you understood the problem."

**PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)**

One theme is that patience and asking for help can solve a difficult problem. Nia keeps trying after the wire slips and asks a volunteer to show her the repair again. She uses the volunteers' advice to fix the wire and check the battery. Nia brings a silent radio to a repair fair, works with volunteers to fix it, and takes home a working radio for her grandfather.

Accept a reasonable theme stated as a general lesson if it is supported by details from the passage. Accept summaries that include Nia's problem, her efforts with the volunteers, and the working radio outcome without adding unimportant details.
