The Playground Clean-Up

Maya dragged wet limbs while adults lifted heavy boards. By noon, everyone was muddy and tired, but the path was safe for children to use again that day.
- ② At the gate, Maya spotted Leo painting a faded sign. He had a Midas touch with colors. When he mixed blue and yellow, the dull wood became a bright green welcome sign. His careful brushstrokes made the letters clear, and even the chipped edges looked fresh and neat by the time he finished painting the sign.
- ③ Still, the work had an Achilles heel. The playground's water fountain leaked, and nobody knew how to fix its broken pipe. Without water, the volunteers had to carry bottles from home. Maya called a plumber, who promised to repair the fountain before the next community clean-up. It was the one problem left to solve.

1	What does "Herculean effort" mean in paragraph 1? Name two actions that give you clues.	It means a very hard, large effort. Maya dragged wet limbs, and adults lifted heavy boards.
2	What does "Midas touch" tell you about Leo? Use details about the sign in your answer.	Leo is very skilled with colors or painting. He changed dull wood into a bright green sign, and the chipped edges looked fresh and neat.
3	What is the playground's "Achilles heel"? Explain what the phrase means in this paragraph.	The leaking water fountain is the Achilles heel. The phrase means the one weak problem that is still difficult to solve.
4	How are "Midas touch" and "Achilles heel" different in meaning in this passage?	A Midas touch is a special strength or skill, while an Achilles heel is a weakness or problem.
