Maya's Evening Garden

- ① At dusk, Maya unlocked the gate to the school garden. The paths, usually busy with boots and backpacks, lay still beneath a violet sky. She had promised to water the beans during the long weekend, but the dry soil had cracked like old paint. As she carried the heavy can, the garden seemed to hold its breath. Even the tomato leaves drooped, waiting for the first cool splash against their dusty stems of the evening.
- ② Water darkened the ground in widening circles. Maya worked slowly, listening to the soft glug of the can. Then she heard a sharp rustle near the fence. Her hands froze. A raccoon stepped from the shadows, its mask bright against the dim grass. It did not charge or growl. Instead, it sniffed one fallen peach, then shuffled away. Maya laughed quietly. The frightening sound had been only a small visitor searching for supper in the garden.
- ③ Before leaving, Maya filled a shallow dish for birds and set it beside the fence. The moon rose above the roof, silvering the wet paths. Now the garden no longer felt like a place that held its breath. It hummed with hidden life, from beetles under stones to wings brushing the air. Maya locked the gate and walked home. Behind her, the beans stood taller, and the garden glimmered like a secret worth keeping through the night.

1	What does the phrase "the garden seemed to hold its breath" mean in paragraph 1?	The garden is very still and quiet, as if it is waiting.
2	What does the word "sharp" suggest about the rustle near the fence? How does it affect the mood?	It suggests a sudden, noticeable sound. It creates a worried or tense mood.
3	How does the description "its mask bright against the dim grass" affect the way the raccoon is presented?	It makes the raccoon stand out from the dark setting, making it seem mysterious or startling.
4	Compare "held its breath" in paragraph 1 with "hummed with hidden life" in paragraph 3. How do these phrases show a change in the garden's mood?	The first phrase makes the garden seem silent and tense. The second makes it seem active, alive, and peaceful.
