HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each named picture book before using the sheet. Hold up the page named in each prompt, read the choices aloud, and support children as they connect the illustration to the beginning, middle, or end of the story.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • SNOWY DAY

SAY “We will look at pages from *The Snowy Day*. Each row has the words First, Middle, and Last. Look at the page I show and circle the word that tells when that picture happens in the story.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Here is the page where Peter looks out and sees new snow. Which word tells when this picture happens in the story? Circle it.	First
b	Here is the page where Peter puts a snowball in his pocket. Which word tells when this picture happens in the story? Circle it.	Middle
c	Here is the page where Peter and his friend go out into the snow together. Which word tells when this picture happens in the story? Circle it.	Last

PART 2 • HUNGRY CATERPILLAR

SAY “Now we will look at pages from *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*. Look at the page I show and circle the word that tells when that picture happens in the story.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Here is the page with the tiny egg on a leaf. Which word tells when this picture happens in the story? Circle it.	First
b	Here is the page where the caterpillar eats through foods. Which word tells when this picture happens in the story? Circle it.	Middle
c	Here is the page with the beautiful butterfly. Which word tells when this picture happens in the story? Circle it.	Last

The *Snowy Day* answers are First, Middle, Last. The *Very Hungry Caterpillar* answers are First, Middle, Last; accept a child pointing to or circling the correct word with teacher support.
