**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read each prompt and the printed choices aloud. Students circle a word, then say the full sentence aloud, and trace sentence starters while speaking a whole thought.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • CHOOSE A WORD**

**SAY** "I will read each row. Can you listen for a word that helps the words make a whole sentence?"

**PART 2 • START AND SAY**

**SAY** "Look at the gray word in each box. For the first box, can you trace I and then say a complete sentence that begins with I? For the second box, can you trace We and then say a complete sentence that begins with We?"

- Box 1: **I**
- Box 2: **We**

**WHAT TO ACCEPT**

Part 1 answers are star, rice, and sleep. In Part 2, accept correct tracing and any spoken complete sentence that begins with the traced word and gives a whole thought, such as "I can read." or "We play outside."
