HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the short text aloud twice before students answer the first part. Students show understanding by answering questions about key details and by saying a question when an important detail is missing.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • LISTEN CLOSELY

SAY “Listen while I read this story two times. Mia has a yellow kite. She goes to the park with Dad. The wind helps the kite fly.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The words are ball, book, kite. What did Mia have? Circle the answer.	kite
b	The words are park, home, school. Where did Mia go? Circle the answer.	park
c	The words are rain, wind, sun. What helped the kite fly? Circle the answer.	wind

PART 2 • ASK MORE

SAY “Sometimes a speaker leaves out a detail. For each row, say the question you would ask to learn more, then circle the question word that helps you ask it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I said, “I put the book somewhere.” Which question word helps you ask about the place? Say your question, then circle the word.	Where
b	I said, “I will read the book at a time I did not tell you.” Which question word helps you ask about the time? Say your question, then circle the word.	When

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are kite, park, and wind. Part 2 answers are Where and When. Accept any spoken clarification question that asks for the missing place or time, even if the child uses different wording.
