HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every script and choice aloud. Students first say a question or answer aloud, then circle a word that matches their thinking. Listen for questions that seek information, ask for help, or clear up a confusing word.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • ASK IT

SAY “Listen to each little situation. Say a question aloud, then listen as I read the three words. Which word starts the question you can ask? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	You want to know the place where a frog lives. You say, “___ does the frog live?” I will read the choices: What, Where, Who. Which word starts your question? Circle it.	Where
b	You do not understand the word tiny. You say, “___ does tiny mean?” I will read the choices: What, Where, Who. Which word starts your question? Circle it.	What
c	You want to know the person who made a card. You say, “___ made this card?” I will read the choices: What, Where, Who. Which word starts your question? Circle it.	Who

PART 2 • ANSWER IT

SAY “Listen to each question and say an answer aloud. I will read the three words in the row. Which word answers the question? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	What does tiny mean? I will read the choices: large, small, fast. Which word answers the question? Circle it.	small
b	Who is a person who can help you read a word? I will read the choices: teacher, pencil, table. Which word answers the question? Circle it.	teacher
c	Where might a bird build a home? I will read the choices: pond, cave, nest. Which word answers the question? Circle it.	nest

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Ask It answers are Where, What, Who. Answer It answers are small, teacher, nest. Accept oral questions and answers that fit the situation, even when a child uses different words.
