A Seed's First Days

- ① A bean seed can rest in dry soil for a long time. When it gets water, the seed coat softens. The tiny plant inside begins to use food stored in the seed.
- ② Soon, a small root pushes down into the soil. The root takes in water and helps hold the young plant steady. A shoot grows up toward light, carrying two first leaves.
- ③ The first leaves use sunlight, air, and water to make food for the plant. As the plant grows, it makes more leaves. Later, a bean plant may grow flowers and bean pods.
