Our Pollinator Garden

- ① Our class wanted a place where butterflies and bees could find food. We chose a sunny corner near the playground for a small pollinator garden. First, we pulled weeds and loosened the soil with hand tools. Then we added compost, which helps soil hold water and gives plants nutrients. We planned rows so each plant would have room to grow.
- ② Next, we planted purple coneflowers, black-eyed Susans, and milkweed. These plants can provide nectar for adult butterflies. Milkweed is the only kind of plant monarch caterpillars eat. After planting, we watered the garden slowly so the water could sink into the ground. We placed a small sign beside the garden to ask visitors not to step on the new plants.
- ③ By the end of spring, the garden had green leaves and bright flowers. We saw bees visiting the blooms and a monarch caterpillar on a milkweed leaf. The garden gave pollinators food, and it showed our class that small actions can help living things. Our pollinator garden became a useful home for insects and a place for students to observe nature.
