Maya's Bean Jar

- ① On Monday morning, Maya brought a clear jar, a paper towel, and three bean seeds to class. First, she wet the towel and pressed it against the inside of the jar. Next, she tucked the seeds between the towel and the glass. Then Maya placed the jar on a sunny shelf, where she could watch the seeds each day.
- ② The next morning, Maya saw that the towel was still damp. After that, she added a few drops of water because seeds need moisture to begin growing. Two days later, a tiny white root pushed out of each seed. Soon, the roots grew longer and curled down toward the bottom of the jar by Friday.
- ③ Finally, green shoots rose above the seeds. Maya measured the tallest shoot with a ruler and wrote its height in her notebook. At the end of the week, she drew what she saw in the jar. Later, Maya took the bean plant home and moved it into a pot with soil, where it could keep growing.
