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**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to look at the large choices or boxes. Students listen to descriptions of analog clock hands, then circle or write the matching digital time for hours and half-hours.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • CIRCLE TIME**

**SAY** “Listen to the clock-hand clues in each row. After I read the choices, circle the digital time that matches the clock hands.”

| a   | The long hand points to 12. The short hand points to 4. The choices are 4:00, 4:30, and 3:00. Which digital time is it? Circle it.               | <b>4:00</b>     |
| b   | The long hand points to 6. The short hand is halfway between 1 and 2. The choices are 1:00, 2:30, and 1:30. Which digital time is it? Circle it. | <b>1:30</b>     |
| c   | The long hand points to 6. The short hand is halfway between 5 and 6. The choices are 5:00, 5:30, and 6:30. Which digital time is it? Circle it. | <b>5:30</b>     |

**PART 2 • WRITE TIME**

**SAY** “In the first box, the long hand points to 12 and the short hand points to 2. What digital time will you write? In the second box, the long hand points to 6 and the short hand is halfway between 3 and 4. What digital time will you write? In the third box, the long hand points to 12 and the short hand points to 6. What digital time will you write?”

- Box 1: **2:00**
- Box 2: **3:30**
- Box 3: **6:00**

**WHAT TO ACCEPT**

Circle Time answers, in order: 4:00, 1:30, 5:30. Write Time answers: 2:00, 3:30, 6:00. Accept clearly written digits with a colon or two dots used as a colon.
