USE TENS FIRST

Break a number into tens and ones. Add or subtract the tens first, then the ones. You can check a subtraction problem by adding.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A shelf has 46 books. Add 27 more books. How many books are there?

1. Break 27 into 20 and 7.
2. $46 + 20 = 66$.
3. $66 + 7 = 73$.
