BREAK APART NUMBERS

Break each number into tens and ones. Add or subtract the tens, then the ones. If you need more ones to subtract, trade one ten for 10 ones.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A jar has 46 buttons. Add 23 more buttons. How many buttons are there?

1. $46 = 40 + 6$.
2. $23 = 20 + 3$.
3. $40 + 20 = 60$ and $6 + 3 = 9$.
4. $60 + 9 = 69$.

Answer: 69 buttons
