PERIMETER MEASURE

Perimeter is the distance around the outside of a flat shape. It uses linear units, such as feet or inches.

A 15-meter rope circles a pool.

AREA MEASURE

Area is the amount of space a flat shape covers. It uses square units, such as square feet or square inches.

A map uses 9 square centimeters of blue ink.

A rectangular patio is 6 feet long and 4 feet wide. Write its perimeter and area with correct units, then tell which measure is linear and which is area.

PART 3 • MAKE YOUR OWN (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- **PERIMETER:** A card needs 18 centimeters of ribbon along its outside.
- **AREA:** A flag has 12 square centimeters of fabric.

Challenge: The perimeter is 20 feet, which is linear. The area is 24 square feet, which is area.
