

Place Value Power

See how each place changes a digit's value.

CCSS.Math.Content.4.NBT.A.1 "Recognize that in a multi-digit whole number, a digit in one place represents ten times what it represents in the place to its right. For example, recognize that $700 \div 70 = 10$ by applying concepts of place value and division."

THE PLACE VALUE RULE

When the same digit moves one place to the left, its value becomes 10 times greater. When it moves one place to the right, its value becomes one tenth as much.

WORKED EXAMPLE

How many times as great is 8,000 as 800?

1. Write the division: $8,000 \div 800$.
2. Rewrite in hundreds: 80 hundreds $\div$ 8 hundreds.
3. Divide: $80 \div 8 = 10$.

Answer: 8,000 is 10 times as great as 800.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- 10 times as many points** Compare 60,000 to 6,000. The 6 in 60,000 is one place to the left of the 6 in 6,000, so its value is 10 times as great.
- 10 times as many views** Divide 900,000 by 90,000. The 9 in 900,000 is one place to the left of the 9 in 90,000, so the quotient is 10.

CHALLENGE

The 7 in the millions place has a value of 7,000,000. The 7 in the thousands place has a value of 7,000. Since $7,000,000 / 7,000 = 1,000$, the first value is 1,000 times as great.

Accept numerical answers or equivalent wording such as "ten times as great." For the challenge, accept 1,000 times with a correct comparison of 7,000,000 and 7,000.
