SAME-SIZE PARTS

Make sure both fractions describe parts of the same whole. When the denominators are the same, add or subtract the numerators and keep the denominator. Simplify the answer if you can.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$2/9 + 5/9 = ?$$

1. Both fractions name ninths.
2. Add the numerators: $2 + 5 = 7$.
3. Keep the denominator: $7/9$.

Answer: $7/9$
