LOOK NEXT DOOR

Find the place you are rounding to, then look at the digit immediately to its right. If that digit is 5 or more, increase the rounding digit by 1. If it is 4 or less, keep the rounding digit the same.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Round 12.364 to the nearest hundredth.

1. The hundredths digit is 6.
2. The digit to its right is 4.
3. Because 4 is less than 5, keep the 6 and drop the 4.

Answer: 12.36

CHALLENGE

A student says that 4.250 rounds to 4.3 when rounded to the nearest tenth. Is the student correct? Explain your reasoning.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **2.79 kilometers** The hundredths digit is 8, and the thousandths digit is 6, so round the 8 up to 9.
2. **18.5 gigabytes** The tenths digit is 4, and the hundredths digit is 5, so round the 4 up to 5.

CHALLENGE

Yes. The tenths digit is 2, and the hundredths digit is 5. Round the 2 up to 3, so 4.250 rounds to 4.3.

Accept equivalent decimal forms, such as 7 for 7.0, if the student clearly rounded to the requested place. For the challenge, accept explanations that identify the tenths digit and the hundredths digit of 5.
