WORK FROM THE INSIDE

Solve the numbers inside grouping symbols before you do the other operations. When grouping symbols are nested, start with the innermost group and work outward. Then multiply or divide before adding or subtracting.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$7 \times [12 + 5]$$

1. $12 + 5 = 17$

2. $7 \times 17 = 119$

Answer: 119

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **84 points** Each team earns $13 + 8 = 21$ points. Multiply 4×21 to get 84 points.
2. **73 glow bracelets** Find the total first: $6 \times 14 = 84$ bracelets. Then subtract 11, so $84 - 11 = 73$.
