UNIT RATE

A unit rate tells how much of one quantity goes with exactly 1 of another quantity. To find it, divide the first quantity by the second quantity. Use the word per to name the rate clearly.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A baker packs 27 rolls into 9 boxes.
What is the unit rate in rolls per box?

1. Write the rate as 27 rolls / 9 boxes.
2. Divide: $27 / 9 = 3$.
3. Name the rate using per.

Answer: 3 rolls per box
