CHOOSE A HELPFUL ORDER

Rewrite subtraction as adding the opposite. Then use the commutative and associative properties to reorder or group numbers that are easy to combine, such as opposites or fractions with a common denominator.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$-17/19 + 6/19 + (-3/19)$$

1. Combine the numerators because all fractions have denominator 19.
2. $-17 + 6 + (-3) = -14$.
3. Write the result as $-14/19$.

Answer: $-14/19$

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **0 points** Add the gains first: $12 + 8 = 20$. Then add the loss: $20 + (-20) = 0$.
2. **-\$3.25** Rewrite the purchase as adding a negative amount: $9.50 + (-12.75) = -3.25$. The negative balance means Nia owes \$3.25.
