WORK WITH SIGNS

To add or subtract rational numbers, use common denominators for fractions and track the signs. For multiplication and division, multiply or divide the absolute values, then use a positive sign when the signs match and a negative sign when they differ.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Find $7/10 + (-3/8)$.

1. Use 40 as a common denominator.
2. $7/10 = 28/40$ and $-3/8 = -15/40$.
3. $28/40 + (-15/40) = 13/40$.

Answer: 13/40

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **\$4.95** Multiply $3 \times \$4.60$ to get \$13.80. Subtract \$13.80 from \$18.75.
2. **2 $\frac{5}{8}$ gigabytes** The episodes use $3 \times 7/8 = 21/8$, or $2 \frac{5}{8}$, gigabytes. Subtract $2 \frac{5}{8}$ from $5 \frac{1}{4}$.
