HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to count quietly or answer from memory. Students show fluency within 5 by choosing the correct numeral and writing a numeral for a spoken equation.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each math question. I will read the number choices too. Circle the number that makes each equation true.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	One plus three equals what number? The choices are 3, 4, and 5. Circle the number that makes the equation true.	4
b	Five minus two equals what number? The choices are 3, 2, and 4. Circle the number that makes the equation true.	3
c	Two plus two equals what number? The choices are 3, 5, and 4. Circle the number that makes the equation true.	4
d	Four minus three equals what number? The choices are 2, 0, 3, and 1. Circle the number that makes the equation true.	1

PART 2 • WRITE IT

SAY “Look at the two boxes. In the first box, what number is five minus three? Write that number. In the second box, what number is one plus one? Write that number.”

- Box 1: **2**
- Box 2: **2**
