Read each question and its answer choices aloud. Students first say the answer they would use, then circle the matching letter. Listen for students to use complete sentences when they share information and speak with others.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • SHARE A THOUGHT

SAY "I will ask a question and read three answers. Say your own answer in a full sentence, then circle the letter for the answer that is a full sentence and fits the question."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	What do you like to do? Listen: A, "Like to jump." B, "I like to jump." C, "Jumping high." Which answer is a full sentence that fits the question?	B
b	Where do you read? Listen: A, "At home." B, "Reading at home." C, "I read at home." Which answer is a full sentence that fits the question?	C
c	Who is your friend? Listen: A, "My friend is Sam." B, "A friend named Sam." C, "Because Sam is kind." Which answer is a full sentence that fits the question?	A

PART 2 • TALK KINDLY

SAY "I will read a talking situation and three answers. Circle the letter for the best full sentence, then say that sentence aloud."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	During a talk, you want a turn to speak. Listen: A, "A turn to talk." B, "Because I have an idea." C, "May I have a turn to talk?" Which answer politely asks for a turn?	C
b	You are working and need help. Listen: A, "Help with this." B, "Could you help me?" C, "Because I need help." Which answer politely asks for help?	B
c	Someone shares an idea. Listen: A, "Your idea." B, "Because your idea." C, "I heard your idea." Which answer is a full sentence that shows you listened?	C
