HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Choose an informational picture book with a title, a table of contents, a glossary, and clear author and illustrator credits. Show the named page or words for each row, read the choices aloud, and have students circle the word that names what they find.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • BOOK PLACES

SAY “Look at our book. For each row, I will point to a place in the book and read the three choices. Which word names the place I am pointing to?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I am pointing to the words on the front cover that tell the book's name. I read Glossary, Title, Contents. Which word names this place?	Title
b	I am pointing to the page that lists sections and page numbers. I read Title, Glossary, Contents. Which word names this place?	Contents
c	I am pointing to the pages that explain special words near the end of the book. I read Glossary, Contents, Title. Which word names this place?	Glossary

PART 2 • BOOK NAMES

SAY “Now look at the names in our book. I will point to a name and read the choices. Which word tells that person's job?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I am pointing to the name printed after the words written by. I read Illustrator, Title, Author. Which word tells this person's job?	Author
b	I am pointing to the name printed after the words illustrated by. I read Author, Illustrator, Glossary. Which word tells this person's job?	Illustrator

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Answers are Title, Contents, Glossary, Author, Illustrator. Accept a response when the student circles the correct label after locating the matching place or name in the teacher's book.
