HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each selection aloud twice before reading its rows aloud. Students listen for who, where, and what happens in the prose story and poem, then circle the word that answers each question.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • STORY LISTEN

SAY “Listen to this short story. Ben has a red kite. He runs to the park with Dad. The wind lifts the kite high. I will read each row, then you will circle one answer.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Who has the red kite: Ben, Dad, or kite? Circle one answer.	Ben
b	Where does Ben run: home, park, or school? Circle one answer.	park

PART 2 • POEM LISTEN

SAY “Listen to this poem. A small bird sings at dawn. It flaps above the tree. Its song wakes Mia. I will read each row, then you will circle one answer.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Who sings at dawn: Mia, tree, or bird? Circle one answer.	bird
b	What does the bird's song do: sleeps, wakes, or flies? Circle one answer.	wakes

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are Ben and park. Part 2 answers are bird and wakes; accept only a clear circle around the correct word.
